Diegesis in Greek Literature of Late Antiquity and Early Middle Ages (3rd to 10th cent.)

20th to 21st November 2014



The aim of the workshop is to organize a meeting of scholars, engaged in the research of narrative elements in the early Medieval Greek Literature.

Topics might include but are not limited to:

- ⊗ a function of storytelling in the early medieval society
- ⊗ a character and development of diegesis in the narrative genres (historiography, hagiography), as well as in other genres containing narrative passages (ascetic literature, rhetoric, epistolography).
- ⊗ a contribution of modern literary theories and their methods to the examination and interpretation of the early medieval literature and society

The papers should not exceed 20 minutes (+ 10 min discussion).

The workshop will be held in English and German.
